To our Stockholders:

You may also revoke your proxy by attending the meeting and voting in person.

The financial statements of the Company for the most recently completed fiscal year ended December 31, 2005 are contained in the accompanying Annual Report.

Please read the proxy materials carefully. Your vote is important and the Company appreciates your cooperation in considering and acting on the matters presented.
